HOLIDAY PROGRAM INFORMATION

Barwon Coast have arranged for a number of activities to be held over the month of January. These activities are suitable for the whole family to enjoy.

Fossil Hunting

What curious creatures lived 25 million years ago? How do we know? Fossils provide the evidence! Discover the amazing species with evidence such as sharks' teeth, scallops, brachiopods and sea dollars. Search for fossils and make your own from Plaster of Paris to take home.

This event is suitable for children over 5 +. Children under 8 years of age must be supervised by an accompanying adult.

Coastal Bush Tucker Discovery

Come for a walk on the beautiful coast, learn about Wathaurung relationships to country, bush tucker and medicines. Try some bush foods and get tribal with some ochre face painting. Tell the story of Bunjil and Waa.

This event is suitable for all ages. Children under 8 years must be accompanied by a supervising adult.

Bush Ranger

Join our Bush Ranger activity to identify a range of habitats in the local bushland and find out about the native animals that live there. You will be guided on a 'tracks & traces

walk' and have a close look at Eco-Logic's preserved bush animals.

Essential clothing requirements:

- Sun protective clothing
- Warm clothes • Comfortable, closed footwear

Rockpool Ramble

Come and learn about the species that live and grow in the intertidal zone, and the adaptations that allow them to survive in this harsh environment. Participants will be shown how to safely and carefully explore the rockpools, and discover species such as seaweeds, crabs and sea snails.

Essential clothing requirements:

- Sun protective clothing
- Warm clothes • Shoes that can get wet, eg old runners, Crocs, or wetsuit shoes/ booties (bare feet and thongs are not acceptable).

Stand Up Paddleboard Explorer

Come and try a SUP Explorer activity, learn paddle boarding skills and techniques on a safe river environment.

You'll have a lot of fun testing those skills, through games, river reading, manoeuvres and exploration. Eco interpretation will be provided throughout the activity.

Suitable for children 12 years and over.

Essential clothing requirements:

- Sun protective clothing • Warm clothes • Shoes that can get wet, eg old runners, Crocs, or wetsuit shoes/ booties (bare feet and thongs are not acceptable).

Beach Detectives

The beach detective activity is based on the mysterious disappearance or unfortunate "accident/death" of an animal or plant from its natural environment. The students work as investigators or detectives, using the clues and activities provided throughout the session to identify the specific environment/habitat (crime site), the effects or victim and the cause (villain).

Essential clothing requirements:

- Sun protective clothing • Warm clothes • Comfortable, closed footwear

A permission form must be filled in for each participant prior to the activity.

PROGRAM INFORMATION

To ensure the Summer Holiday program runs smoothly there are a few things that parents must note.

Participants must be pre-booked at the caravan park office prior to the start of the activity. If unable to attend you must notify the caravan park as soon as possible.

A Permission Form for each participant must be completed prior to each activity.

All participants must be signed in by a parent or guardian.

Participants under the age of 6 must have a parent/guardian 18+ years of age must remain with them during the activity.

Stand up paddle board participants must be over 12 years of age.

All participants must be signed out by a parent/guardian.

All participants must be collected on time.

For all activities, the participant contact person must be within a 10 minute radius of the activity site and be contactable during the activity times.

Campers may book into activities at either park. However, guests at a particular park will get first preference for an activity at that park.

A feedback form can be collected at the end of all activities. Please fill these out and return to the park office to let us know what you did and did not like!
